LC3 Board Vacancies & Elections



Nomination Deadline (ONLINE FORM ONLY): 11.9.23 at 1:00PM / 1300 MST.

After Form Deadline, <u>floor nominations will be accepted at the 11.14.23 LC3 General Meeting</u> (<u>11:30am</u>). TODAY**

Nominees must be present in the virtual Zoom conference in order to be considered for election. Election will take place at the end of the Nomination session today.

The nominees will be announced, then the voting will take place.

The election results will be announced at the December 12, LC3 annual meeting.

<u>**Please note that each nomination will be recorded only to be reviewed by the current LC3 board</u> / staff & to promote transparency and validity.**

Board member obligations:

- Attend LC3 board meetings (1st Tuesday/month, 11:30-1)
- Attend LC3 general meeting (3rd Tuesday/month, 11:30-1)
- Attend LC3 events & trainings when possible
- LC3 Collaborative Ambassador (recruit new members, presentations, etc.)

<u>Term (Bylaws):</u>

The term of office for all Board of Directors shall be three years, or in the case of an Board of Directors member filling a vacancy (Proxy), the remainder of the replacement term. An individual may not serve more than two consecutive terms on the board*. Board member may be nominated to the board again after a 3 year hiatus.

*Additional information regarding Board of Director Proxy can be provided upon request.

This position is not compensated.

The LC3 Board is limited up to 9 members. We can elect up to three new board members.

Purpose of LC3:

"Provide individual with lived experiences, family members, providers and others an opportunity to participate in the LC3 Collaborative to build the Ideal Behavioral Health System for the citizens of Dona Ana County using the Collective Impact strategy"

Voting

Who can vote for new board members according to the LC3 bylaws?

Voting: Voting will be by consensus whenever possible and by a simple majority when consensus is not reached. In order to vote, one must be a voting member.

Voting Members:

<u>Any member meeting that membership requirement may become a voting member after attending 3</u> <u>local collaborative meetings or events within a 6 month period.</u> After voting member status is achieved, members must attend at least 50% of the meetings in the calendar year to retain voting member status. New members who join the collaborative within a calendar year must attend at least 50% of the meetings since they achieved voting member status. A member can have 1 vote either as an individual member or as a representative of their organization.

How We Promote Transparency at LC3

- After the votes have been cast via secured google forms, the voters will be <u>compared amongst a database of past attendance of LC3</u> <u>Events (Hence why sign in is required) in order to determine vote</u> validity.
- Once the votes are confirmed and validated, then the <u>nominees will be</u> <u>compared to the database of attendance as well & qualifications</u>.
- After the data & valid ballots have been collected and cross examined, the winning nominees will be contacted and they will be <u>announced at</u> <u>the December 12.2023 Annual Meeting.</u>
