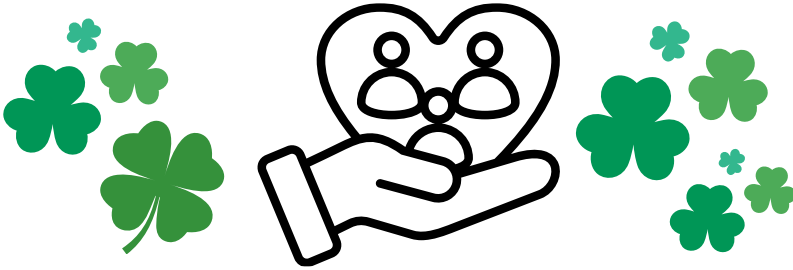

- **LC3 Conducts Community needs assessment, gap analysis and subsequent 3-year strategic plan to close system gaps amidst another pandemic disruption. LC3 proved to be an effective vehicle for coordination and resilience as a central hub of information and action during the pandemic. The long-term vision for LC3 is to develop an ecosystem of coordinated communication and collaboration amongst providers to improve health outcomes by building capacity for system interventions.**

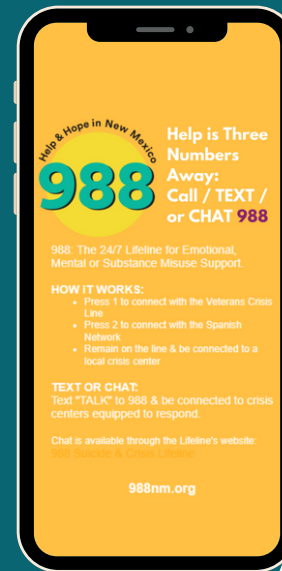
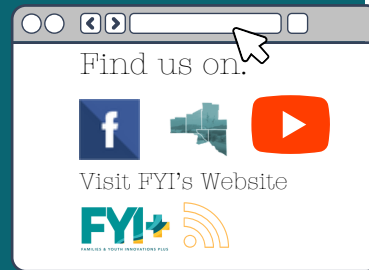
