• Hector Duran, CEO for Las Cruces Recovery Center. Born in El Paso and raised in Las Cruces. **Graduate of Las Cruces High School. Started first** syringe exchange program in 1998 as an **Outreach Worker for Families and Youth, Inc** under the HIV prevention programs. Left for Arizona in 2001 and has been working in mental health, public health and social services for 33 years. Mr Duran is also in recovery celebrating 24 years in June of 2024. He was previously the **Director of Health and Human Services for the** Tohono O'odham Nation, a Native Tribe in Arizona and only came back for the opportunity to come back home to Las Cruces to follow through on fulfilling his dream of seeing a facility open to serve the needs of those struggling with addiction.
